About our Sessions

Fantastic Babies: supports babies' development through songs, stories and play ideas.

Fantastic One's and Fantastic Two's:

supporting children between 1-3 years with their development through songs, stories plus age and stage appropriate play activities. Sessions also include easing the transition from home to nursery, for children eligible for 2 year old funding but not yet attending a setting

Stay, Play & Learn: This group is for children aged 0 - 3yrs,6 months old and their Parents and *main Carers.

Let's get Messy: Children 0-4years will experience a wide variety of textures and materials to imagine, investigate, explore, and learn through their senses

Getting Ready For Nursery: children will have opportunities to play with quality resources, develop their independence, and be introduced to a simple nursery school routine. Support and advice from the Early Years Practitioners, Speech & Language therapists, Educational Psychologists, Health Professionals and Teachers is also available.

Baby Massage: A wonderful opportunity for you to learn how to communicate with your baby through nurturing touch and massage in a relaxed and welcoming environment. Priority will be given to those babies who may need it the most.

Bucket Time: To help to develop your child's listening and attention skills and support their early communication skills.

Enhanced Stay Play and Learn: A quieter group for children with a range of emerging needs

Communication Playgroup: Delivered by Speech and Language therapists to develop children's social communication and language skills through play

Toddler group: For parents breastfeeding children 18 months to 3 years old

Breast Feeding Group: breastfeeding support available to parents and carers.

ESOL – English classes to help improve English language skills – supported by a creche (spaces to be booked)

Talk Shop Advice Clinic: 9.30 to 11.00am

If you have any concern about your child's Speech and Language development, please speak to a member of the Children's Centre team for information on drop-in sessions where you can speak to our assistant speech and language therapist. This session is for children 2.5years and under with Wandsworth GP
