- Deciding on a nursery, school or college for your child or young person

- Your options, when you do not agree with a decision made about your child or young person
- Exclusions from a nursery, school or college
- Transport applications
- Independent mediation and SEND Tribunal Appeals
- Other services that might be able to help you


